School Uniform

Our school uniform remains unchanged in September, and we expect all children to be wearing it; Black or grey trousers or skirts/pinafores, white polo shirt/blouse, royal blue sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan and black shoes. Items with the school logo are available from the Uniform Shop in Morley and most supermarkets sell plain uniform in our colours. The school office also sells iron on school badges for £2.00. PE Uniform
